Herbal Wreath Making Workshop

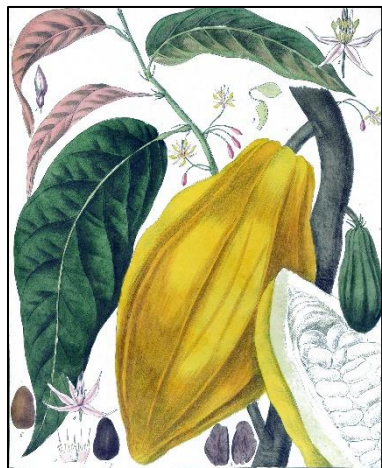
