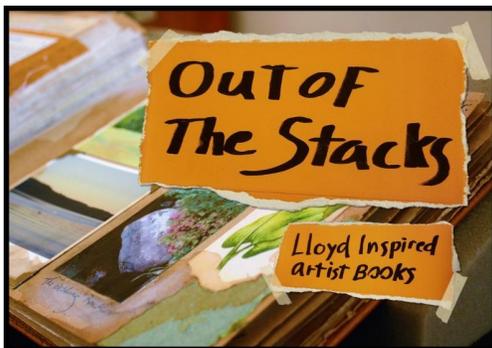


Lloyd Library & Museum News

Where: Lloyd Library & Museum

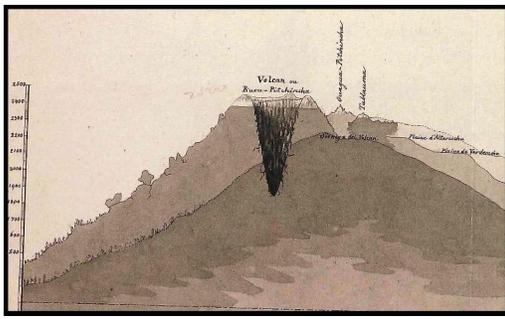
Based on the popularity of last year's wreath making workshop, we're announcing this year's event early. Reservations required.

Humboldt's Drawings and Travel Diaries

Alexander von Humboldt is considered not only an explorer and naturalist, but the father of the environmental movement. His legacy lives on in the Lloyd's



collections with the newly published and wonderfully illustrated *The Complete Drawings from the American Travel Diaries*. This oversized work details Humboldt's early 19th century travels and meticulous documenting of all things natural in the Americas (volcano sketch pictured at left).
