### Out of the Stacks Opening Reception



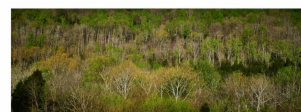
When: Friday, September 28, 5:30-8 p.m.

The upcoming *Out of the Stacks* exhibition features *A Year on the Edge: A Photographic Narrative of the Edge of Appalachia Preserve* with photographs from Rick Conner and TJ Vissing. Owned and operated by The Nature Conservancy and Cincinnati Museum Center, the Edge of Appalachia Preserve is Ohio's largest privately owned protected natural area. Located in Adams County, Ohio, it consists of eleven unique preserves including: Cedar Falls, Buzzardroost Rock, Lynx Prairie, Cave Hollow, and the Rieveschl Preserves.
