### Lloyd Library Awarded Conservation Grant by State Library



Thanks to a grant from the Institute of Museum and Library Services (IMLS) awarded by the State Library of Ohio, the Lloyd Library & Museum is moving forward with the conservation of two rare illustrated botanical books, the 1835 French illustrated work *Flore d'Amerique* and *Pomona Herefordiensis*, published in London around 1822. The conservation work will allow both fragile books to be once again available for use by researchers.

Artwork on display will include 18th and 19th century nature prints, as well as photographic images of central Ohio captured from dawn to dusk. This marks the Lloyd Library's fourth year as a participating venue in FotoFocus.
