
Writing Workshop Unearths Hidden Treasures

The Chocolate Passport Coming in February




When: February 7, 6-8 p.m.

Flowers of Japan Donated to Lloyd

The Lloyd Library recently acquired the 1891 work *Flowers of Japan*, originally owned by Richard Ison (pictured at right) and donated by his daughter Janet Baltzersen. While stationed in the Navy in Japan, the book, with its beautiful wood block-printed illustrations, caught the eye of Ison, who brought it back to the United States. Moving his family to Melbourne, Australia before returning to Cincinnati, Ison had a career in the printing and newspaper industry. Now, we at the Lloyd Library are proud to share this special work with others.
