Abstract: The collection comprises the papers, work activities, research, correspondence and other items recording the career of Dr. Norman Robert Farnsworth, an American pharmacist and pharmacognosist of the mid-late 20th century, 1956-2008. Key series document the history of the American Society of Pharmacognosy, the Amazon Natural Drug Company, the Plant Science Seminar, Consultation, Correspondence, Academic Correspondence, and the World Health Organization. Paper is the primary format of the materials.

Arrangement: The collection consists of 162 boxes divided into ten series.

Biographical History: Dr. Norman Robert Farnsworth was a renowned pharmacist and pharmacognosist of the twentieth century. He was born in Lynn, Massachusetts on March 23, 1930. He was a Korean War veteran, briefly serving in the Army from 1950-1951. Afterwards, he attended the Massachusetts College of Pharmacy for his Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Pharmacy. He then attended the University of Pittsburgh to receive his Doctoral in Pharmacognosy and taught as a professor there through the 1960s. In 1970, he became a professor of

Pharmacognosy at the University of Illinois at Chicago for 42 years. Dr. Farnsworth was involved with many societies and organizations including: American Botanical Council, American Society of Pharmacognosy, the Society for Economic Botany, and the World Health Organization. He created the database Natural Product Alert (NAPRALERT) which stores studies, reports, and reviews on natural products and medicinal plants from around the world. He also served as a consultant and researcher for independent companies and litigation cases. He died in Chicago on September 10, 2011.

Scope and Content: The collection comprises the pharmacist and pharmacognosist papers, work activities, research, correspondence and other items recording the career of Dr. Norman Robert Farnsworth during the years 1956-2008. The collection is undergoing archival processing. New series and additions to existing series will be accessible in accordance with the archives processing schedule.

Farnsworth earned degrees at the what is now the Massachusetts College of Pharmacy and Health Sciences before going on to the University of Pittsburgh, where he received his doctorate in 1959. He taught there until he was recruited by the University of Illinois, Chicago in 1970. Farnsworth studied the medicinal properties of plants for over 50 years, the majority as Professor of Pharmacognosy on the faculty of the University of Illinois, Chicago. He was a founder and charter member of the American Society of Pharmacognosy.

Farnsworth was a member of the World Health Organization's Expert Advisory Panel on Traditional Medicine. He became a consultant in the 1980s and supported the organization's growth from a single location to its present 18 centers. His contributions include publishing guidelines on research methods in herbal medicines, work on safety standards, guidelines for plant collection practices and identification of active compounds in plants.

In the mid-1990s, Farnsworth was appointed to President Bill Clinton's Commission on Dietary Supplements Labels and worked to establish requirements for supplement manufacturers in the quest to improve consumer safety. His research won him many awards, including in 2005 the Research Achievement Award from the American Society of Pharmacognosy.

Series I: American Society of Pharmacognosy (1956-1977, 1979, 1981-1982, 1985-1994, 2002-2003), 12 Boxes. The American Society of Pharmacognosy (ASP) was co-founded by Dr. Farnsworth in 1958. It was born out of the existing Plant Science Seminar, created for members to promote and share the study of pharmacognosy and natural products. Dr. Farnsworth served a term as president in 1962 and remained a board member serving and heading various committees for the rest of his life. Included in this series are correspondence to various members of the ASP, member directories and lists, reports, copies of the ASP constitution, papers related to ASP's annual meetings, meeting minutes, newsletters, programs, booklets, photographs, and books.

Series II: ANDCO – Amazon Natural Drug Company (1970-1973), 1 Box. Dr. Farnsworth served as an adviser and researcher for the Amazon Natural Drug Company (ANDCO), located in South America. In Peru, he conducted research on natural compounds found in native plants. ANDCO was a front company for the United States Central Intelligence Agency for the research of toxic compounds in part of their mind-control research for the MKSEARCH program. Included in this series are research reports and correspondence from Dr. Farnsworth.

Series III: Plant Science Seminar (1957-1959), 1 Box. The precursor to the American Society of Pharmacognosy was the Plant Science Seminar, also known as the Plant Science Laboratory Seminar. This group originally organized at the University of Minnesota in 1923 and continued to hold annual meetings until 1959 when the assembly changed to American Society of Pharmacognosy. Included are annual meeting itineraries, travel brochures and maps, papers written by Dr. Farnsworth, and group photographs.

Series IV: Consultation (1983-2001). Dr. Farnsworth served as a consultant for numerous organizations and corporations. (Archival processing for this series is in progress.)

IV.A.: Tom's of Maine (1996-2001), 1 Box. Dr. Farnsworth served as a consultant and researcher for potential new wellness products for the natural personal care products company Tom's of Maine. Included in this series are correspondence, meeting minutes and summaries, ingredient research, and draft product descriptions and labels. (Access is restricted.)

IV.B.: Boling vs. Sunrider Lawsuit (1983, 1985-1993), 7 Boxes. Dr. Farnsworth was a researcher for the Boling vs. Sunrider Lawsuit of 1990 in Arizona. He investigated the products sold by Sunrider and the claims the plaintiff made against the company. Dr. Farnsworth gave a deposition about his findings in the court case. Included are correspondence, depositions, lab results, exhibits, research articles/studies and notes. (Access is restricted.)

IV.C.: Shaman Pharmaceuticals (Archival processing for this series is in progress.)

Series V: Correspondence (1938-2007), 21 Boxes. Dr. Farnsworth organized his correspondence alphabetically and chronologically. It reflects his research pursuits, partnerships, academic career, and personal life.

V.A. Society For Economic Botany (1959-1997), 2 Boxes. Dr. Farnsworth was an instrumental scientist in founding the Society for Economic Botany (SEB). The organization was established to foster and encourage scientific research, education, and related activities on the past, present, and future uses of plants, and the relationship between plants and people, and to make the results of such research available to the scientific community and the general public through meetings and publications. His archives document the SEB's origin, committees, conferences, membership recruitment, funding, and leadership.

V.B. S.B. Penick & Company (1959-1972), 1 Box. Dr. Farnsworth corresponded with S.B. Penick & Company regarding crude drug plant sources and acquisitions.

V.C. Gordon H. Svoboda (1950-1993), 2 Boxes. Dr. Svoboda (1923-2007) worked for Eli Lilly and Company during the 1950s-1980s. Dr. Farnsworth and Dr. Svoboda were long-term friends and colleagues. They worked together on research publications, the establishment of the American Society of Pharmacognosy, the Society For Economic Botany, and explored the feasibility of founding organic-chemistry oriented commercial partnerships. (Access is restricted.)

V.D. Eli Lilly and Company (1965-1975), 1 Box. The company was founded in 1876 by Colonel Eli Lilly. Colonel Lilly created high-quality medicines to treat and cure diseases. Dr. Farnsworth was a frequent contributor in the company's publication *Tile & Till*, which advertised Eli Lilly

products, provided information about pharmaceutical drugs, and their sources. Dr. Farnsworth corresponded with numerous scientists regarding crude drug alkaloids and extracts. (Access is restricted.)

V.E. Florence & Alvin Segelman (1970-1982), 1 Box. Both Drs. Segelman were pharmacognosy students of Dr. Farnsworth. Dr. Florence (Pettler) Segelman was employed by the Amazon Natural Drug Company in the 1970s.

V.F. American Botanical Council--ABC (1979-2002), 2 Boxes. ABC Provides information about herbs based on modern science and traditional wisdom. ABC publishes peer-reviewed books, monographs, safety reviews, continuing education materials, searchable online databases, and *Herbalgram*, the quarterly journal of the American Botanical Council. Dr. Farnsworth was a long-term friend of Mark Blumenthal, ABC founder and Executive Director. He served on the ABC Board of Trustees and Advisory Board. (Access is restricted.)

V.G. Ezekiel Abayomi Sofowora (1978-1980), 1 Box. Dr. Sofowora (1943-2015) was a specialist in pharmacognosy with a special emphasis on phytochemistry, specification of standards for medicinal plants and ethno-botanical surveys on which he authored numerous scientific papers and books. For most of his career, he served as Professor in the Department of Pharmacognosy, Obafemi Awolowo University of Ife, Nigeria. Drs. Sofowora and Farnsworth collaborated in the World Health Organization.

Series VI: Academic Correspondence (1919-2010), 11 Boxes. Dr. Farnsworth organized his academic correspondence alphabetically and chronologically. It reflects his research pursuits, partnerships, and academic career throughout his work at Massachusetts College of Pharmacy, Boston, Massachusetts, University of Pittsburgh, Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania, and University of Illinois, Chicago, Illinois.

VI.A. University of Pittsburgh (1958-1972), 1 Box. University of Pittsburgh correspondence.

VI.B. *The Vinca Alkaloids. Botany, Chemistry, and Pharmacology* (1967-1974), 1 Box. Vinca book correspondence.

VI.C. Rho Chi Society (1970-1977), 1 Box. Correspondence regarding Dr. Farnsworth's leadership in the academic honor society in pharmacy.

VI.D. University of Illinois, Department of Pharmacognosy and Pharmacology (1965-1989), 10 Boxes. The Department of Pharmacognosy and Pharmacology offered studies leading to degrees in Pharmacognosy at the masters and doctoral levels. Major research areas focused on the isolation, structure elucidation, bioassay and mechanism of action of plant constituents having biological activity. Dr. Farnsworth was an integral leader in the department. The records reflect his research pursuits, departmental leadership and administration, and academic career at the University of Illinois, Chicago.

VI.D.1. Around-the-World-Trip 1973-1976, 1 Box. Dr. Farnsworth traveled throughout Europe and the Mediterranean during 1974. The records document his travels, the preparations, and outcomes.

VI.D.2. Data to Oppose Reorganization of the University of Illinois, Department of Pharmacognosy and Pharmacology – Program for Collaborative Research In The Pharmaceutical Sciences Proposal 1970-1982, 1 Box. (Access is restricted)

VI.D.3. Norman R. Farnsworth Administration 1969-1978, 1 Box. Dr. Farnsworth was an integral leader in the Department of Pharmacognosy and Pharmacology. The records reflect his research pursuits, departmental leadership and administration, and academic career at the University of Illinois, Chicago.

VI.E. University of Illinois, Program for Collaborative Research In The Pharmaceutical Sciences (PCRPS) (1981-2009), 10 Boxes. The PCRPS is an international research center for the study of biologically active natural products. The PCRPS was established to bring together faculty within the University of Illinois to pursue research and development projects that are pertinent to the biomedical sciences and the pharmaceutical sciences. Dr. Farnsworth was a founder and integral leader in the PCRPS. The records reflect his research pursuits, program leadership and administration, and academic career at the University of Illinois, Chicago.

VI.F. University of Illinois, College of Pharmacy (1985-2009), 2 Boxes. Dr. Farnsworth was an integral leader in the college. The records reflect his research pursuits, college leadership and administration, and academic career at the University of Illinois, Chicago.

Series VII. NAPRALERT Correspondence Series 1977-2008, 5 Boxes. Dr. Farnsworth created the database Natural Product Alert (NAPRALERT) which stores studies, reports, and reviews on natural products and medicinal plants from around the world. NAPRALERT is a relational database of natural products, including ethnomedical information, pharmacological and biochemical information on extracts of organisms in vitro, in situ, in vivo, and in human studies--case reports, non-clinical trials, and clinical studies. Similar information is available for secondary metabolites from natural sources.

Series VIII. ANDCO – Amazon Natural Drug Company Correspondence 1960-1986, 12 Boxes. Dr. Farnsworth served as an adviser and researcher for the Amazon Natural Drug Company (ANDCO), located in Iquitos, Peru. He supervised and conducted research on natural compounds found in native plants. ANDCO was a front company for the United States Central Intelligence Agency for the research of toxic compounds in part of their mind-control research for the MKSEARCH program. Included in this series are research reports and correspondence from Dr. Farnsworth and ANDCO employees. (Access is restricted for selected folders.)

Series IX. Academia (Archival processing in progress.)

IX.A. Harry Fong 19__-20__ (Archival processing in progress.)

Series X. World Health Organization 1955- 2005, 4 Boxes. Dr. Farnsworth's was involved in two separate programs related to WHO: the WHO Special Programme on Research, Development and Research Training, Task Force on Plants for Fertility Regulation, and the WHO Collaborating Center for Traditional Medicine at UIC (WHO TRM at UIC.) Contains general contents related to the World Health Organization (WHO) including global meeting programs and booklets, and published materials.

Sub-Series X.A. UIC Dept of Pharm Series including WHO Collaborating Centers of Traditional Medicine and PCRPS 1978-2007, 13 Boxes. Dr. Farnsworth was involved with the six research centers underneath the Collaborating Center. He served as the director from 1981-2011. Contains papers relating to the UIC College of Pharmacy, the Program for Collaborative Research in Pharmaceutical Studies, articles edited by the UIC professors in the Dept. of Pharmacy. Features printouts for the Herb Trade Association.

Sub-Series X.B. WHO Special Programme on Research, Development and Research Training, Task Force on Plants for Fertility Regulation 1974-2006, 20 Boxes. Dr. Farnsworth was involved from 1977-1988, serving as a Steering Committee member of the task force. The Task Force was responsible for researching natural means for fertility regulation. Included in this series are meeting minutes and agendas, working papers, and the final product: "Development Of A Predictive Method to Identify Fertility-Regulating Plants By Means Of Computer Analysis Of Existing Literature."

Sub-Series X.C. Fertility Research (1857-1996), 14 Boxes. These subject files were labeled by Dr. Farnsworth and are related to his work with WHO. Additionally, parts of this collection of fertility research were not specified to projects he was working on and were most likely used for reference. Included are scholarly papers, lab results, and booklets.

Sub-Series X.D. NAPRAAlert Coding and Entries (1927-1983), 2 Boxes. NAPRAAlert was an essential tool for the organization of the fertility research projects Dr. Farnsworth and collaborating researchers worked on. Print outs of organisms related to fertility research for WHO. Includes IBM punch cards from the National Institute of Health's National Cancer Institute, coding forms, and NAPRAAlert print outs.

Series XI. Conferences and Symposiums (1944-1991), 5 Boxes. These series' focus on Dr. Farnsworth's participation in additional conferences focusing on natural drug production, and AIDS research. It includes programs, pamphlets and packets from his attendance.
