

Celebrate the Season with Sylvan Roots at the Lloyd Library

As winter approaches and we look toward the holidays, trees are an ever-present part of the season. Their strength and majesty provide examples of resilience and dignity. The Lloyd Library celebrates trees in its latest exhibition, *Sylvan Roots*, opening December 9. The exhibition takes its name from the Latin word "sylva," meaning "wood or forest," and the term "sylva," which is used in early encyclopedic works and censuses of trees.

Sylvan Roots showcases the Lloyd's extensive collection of books on trees spanning the 17th to 20th centuries and explores

topics including the medicinal properties of trees, the fruits and nuts they bear, and the military and economic uses of trees. A journey through the exhibition reveals an evolving perspective of trees from a utilitarian viewpoint to a focus on botany and the plants. Feast your eyes on vibrant illustrations depicting leaves, fruit, and bark. Exhibition highlights include *Sylva* by John Evelyn (1664), and the first published work on trees of North America, *The North American Sylva*, by François André Michaux (1817-1819). The exhibition continues through March 24.



In the gallery, view the stunning nature photography of Rick Conner and TJ Vissing. Threads of Light is a photo exhibit that tells the story of how light weaves it's magic through the Big Darby Creek region of Central Ohio.

Ring in the holiday season and revel with others in the beauty and multiple vantage points offered by trees.
