## Welcome 2023 Fellows and Artist-in-Residence



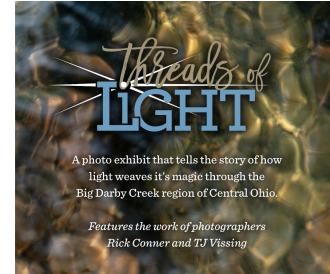
