

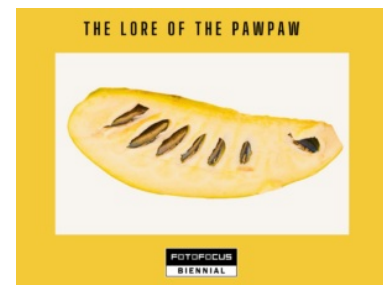

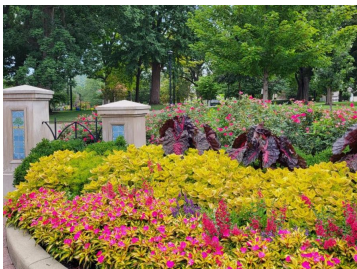
The Lore of the Pawpaw Opening Reception

When: Wednesday, October 9, 7-8 p.m.

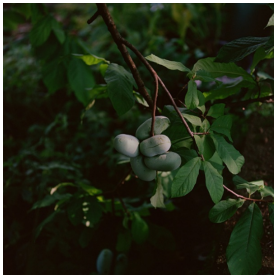
