Join art historian Lindsay Wells to explore how innovative new forms of gardening and greenhouse technology helped houseplants survive and thrive in the sooty air of Industrial Revolution-era Great Britain. As Victorians cultivated miniature gardens within their homes, these spaces became showcases for ornamental plants, often sourced far and wide from regions tied to British colonialism. This Victorian history of houseplants highlights how a desire for environmental renewal entwined with imperial expansion. Registration required.
