Britain. As Victorians cultivated miniature gardens within their homes, these spaces became showcases for ornamental plants, often sourced far and wide from regions tied to British colonialism. This Victorian history of houseplants highlights how a desire for environmental renewal entwined with imperial expansion. Registration required.
