The Eclectics with John S. Haller, Jr.

Join medical historian and author John S. Haller, Jr. for a deep dive into Eclectic medicine, including the Eclectic Medical Institute in Cincinnati, whose 97-year history offers a unique insight into this notable healing philosophy. This American alternative medical movement began in 1827 with the opening of the U.S. Infirmary in New York City and shunned the excessive use of bleeding and harsh drugs. Its founders prescribed botanical medicines based on the principle that physicians should employ whatever was found to be beneficial to their patients. **Registration required.**
