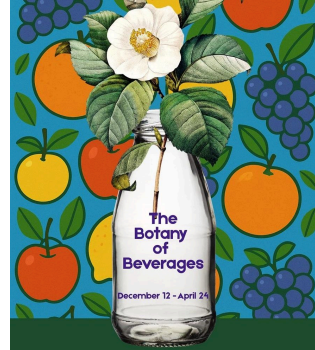

The Botany of Beverages Opening Reception

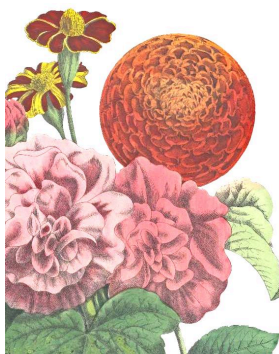
When: Friday, December 12, 5-7 p.m.
