Haile, Jr. Foundation to support *More than Human Medicine: Honoring the Plants and Animals that Make Treatments Possible*, featuring the work of Lloyd's 2025 Artist-in-Residence, Sara Torgison. Opening this spring, *More than Human Medicine* is an exhibition and program series that uses art to explore plant and animal contributions to the optimization of human health. Through botanical illustrations dating back to the eighteenth century and original art created by The Lloyd artist-in-residence Sara Torgison, topics such as traditional medicine, modern medical advances and lab research are brought to life and explored through a new lens. Sara Torgison is an interdisciplinary artist specializing in ceramics and fiber art. Her work blends media to highlight fragile surfaces and marginal spaces.



The Carol Ann and Ralph V. Haile, Jr. Foundation grant to The Lloyd Library & Museum will aid in the production and installation of the exhibition. Grant money will also support an opening reception and several free programs offered virtually or filmed and posted on The Lloyd's YouTube channel to provide greater accessibility and to spread the reach of the programs nationally and globally.
