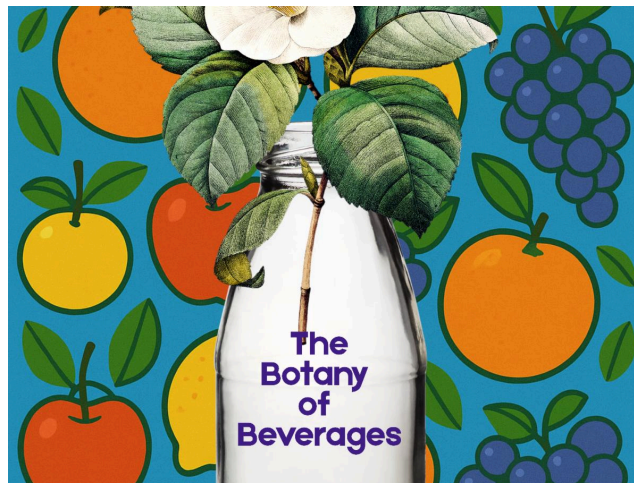
***The Botany of Wines* has Sold Out**
