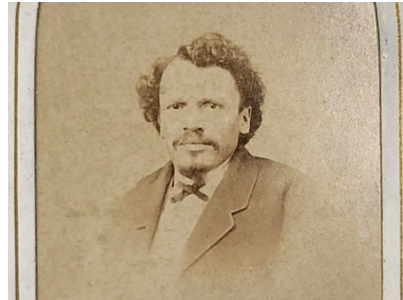

Honoring Black History Month

The Lloyd celebrates Black History Month and African American contributions to medicine with a spotlight on Dr. William R. Reynolds (pictured), a member of the class of 1868 and the first recorded Black graduate from Cincinnati's Eclectic Medical Institute. Other early Black EMI students include [the heroic Dr. R.H. Tate](#), enrolled in 1874, Dr. James T. Broadnax (class of 1904), Dr. Charles E. Horner (class of 1907), and the Hickman brothers: Dr. Clifford J. Hickman (class of 1889) and Dr. Benjamin Hickman, Jr. (class of 1891). Lloyd co-founder John Uri Lloyd taught at the EMI. Its books and archives form part of The Lloyd's collections.

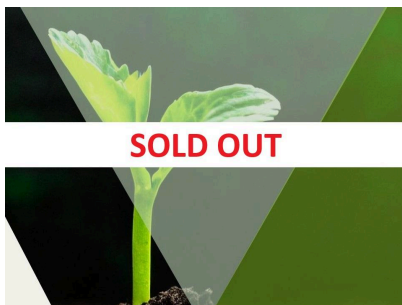
Join 2025 Lloyd Fellows Meghan Henshaw and Julia Orquera Bianco for a deep dive into Cincinnati's legacy of nature-based medicine in the 19th- and early 20th-century through archival research and contemporary art.

Flora's Daughters: Seven Plants Through the Lens of Eclectic Medicine, Contemporary Herbalism, and Botanical Illustration draws on historical herbalism, modern sustainability, and the overlooked contributions of women botanists and illustrators. The end result combines research-based writing with cyanotype prints enhanced by watercolor and ink (detail pictured) into an accessible resource connecting The Lloyd's collections to contemporary conversations.
