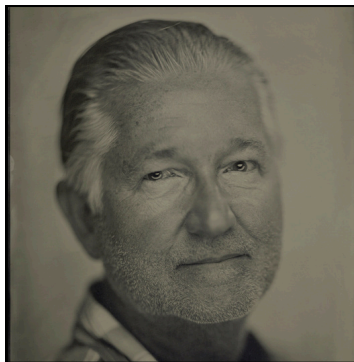

Elevar Fund Awards Grant to the Lloyd Library & Museum for *Beyond the Gate*

The Lloyd Library & Museum is pleased to announce that it has been awarded a grant from the Elevar Fund to help support its fall exhibition, *Kent Krugh: Beyond the Gate* as part of the 2026 FotoFocus Biennial: *The Long View*. The mission of the Elevar Fund is to encourage and advance visionary organizations and movements focused on innovative approaches to complex social and environmental issues. One of the ways the Elevar Fund achieves this is through fueling creativity, building skills, and celebrating culture through arts and education.

Opening September 25, Kent Krugh's multi-exposure images in *Beyond the Gate* invite viewers to experience time as layered and interconnected, linking past, present, and future through evocative portraits of trees. Expanding on his acclaimed series *Inside the Gate*, Krugh superimposes moments at sites deeply rooted in the Lloyd Brothers' history from the woods of Crittenden, Kentucky, to Spring Grove Cemetery and Arboretum, and Ithaca, New York. His organic, botanical imagery conveys reflection, patience, and a sense of calm while honoring place, history, and memory.
